

EnumObjectsProc

The **EnumObjectsProc** function is an application-defined callback function that processes object data supplied by the **EnumObjects** function.

```
VOID CALLBACK EnumObjectsProc(  
    LPVOID lpLogObject,      // address of graphic-object structure  
    LPARAM lpData           // address of application-defined data  
);
```

Parameters

lpLogObject

Points to a **LOGPEN** or **LOGBRUSH** structure describing the attributes of the object.

lpData

Points to the application-defined data passed by the **EnumObjects** function.

Return Value

This function does not return a value.

Remarks

An application must register this function by passing its address to the **EnumObjects** function. **EnumObjectsProc** is a placeholder for the application-defined function name.
